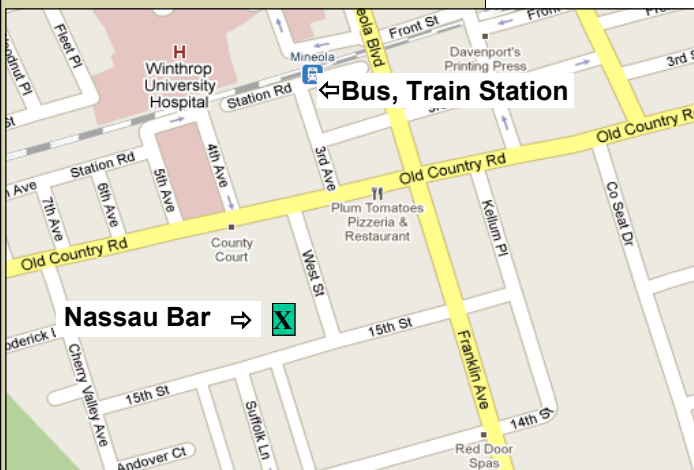

- **ABLE Act**, federal and state legislation that eases financial strains faced by individuals with disabilities by making tax-free savings accounts available to cover qualified expenses such as education, housing, and transportation.
- **Supplemental Needs Trusts (SNT)**, trusts that are created for persons with disabilities which can supplement government benefits, such as Medicaid and SSI, without disqualifying the individual from receiving such benefits.
- **Options to help plan** for future care of disabled adults and "soon to be" adults.
